Last Chance OEC Refresher Fall 2015 By: Betty Adams, MWP Patrol Rep



Is it time to start thinking about OEC refresher? Again this year there will be an OEC Refresher at Minocqua Winter Park on Sunday, November 1. Carolyn DeJongh will be Instructor of Record. Don't wait until the last minute. Be sure to contact Carolyn at 715-369-1563 or cdej@charter.net if you plan to attend. This year's refresher will be a Hybrid Refresher. This means you must complete an on-line portion, print a certificate of completion and bring the certificate to the refresher. On November 1 the refresher will be scenarios and skill stations only. NO CERTIFICATE; NO REFRESHER. Details from National are slow in coming this year. We should have details early before end of summer. We need to know if you plan to attend so we can send final details when we know them. Please, this is very important! Also we plan to sell lunch so we need to know how many to prepare for. The refresher will be held and you are welcome. We enjoy providing for everyone. The most frequently asked question is How do you get to MWP?

You should follow these directions for excellent cross country skiing, tubing, snowshoeing and ice skating and the OEC refresher. Drive west on Highway 70 from the intersection with Highway 51 in Minocqua. About 6.8 miles west turn left on Squirrel Lake Road. There is a brown Minocqua Winter Park sign on Highway 70 marking the road. About 4.7 miles on Squirrel Lake Road then turn left on Scotchmans Lake Road (it is gravel). There is a large MWP sign on the corner. Go 0.3 of a mile then turn right – again there is a sign. Go 0.2 of a mile then turn left through a gate and continue to the parking lot. The address is 7543 Squirrel Hill Road, Minocqua, WI 54548. Plan on driving about 30 minutes from the intersection of highways 51 and 70.

OEC Update By: Chris Dobrinski, OEC Administrator

Everyone should have received the 2015 OEC Cycle B refresher guide in the mail by now. Some of you may have already finished the work book. Well, if you did, you'll be happy to know that, according to National, the workbook is now a mandatory part of the refresher and SHALL be completed prior to attending either the hands-on portion of the hybrid or the traditional refresher. My first review of the guide suggests that access to the 5th edition will be needed to complete the workbook. I know many of you do not have the book, so call an OEC instructor or your patrol rep, as they were all provided a copy of the 5th ed. by the region, and they may be able to share it with you in the next few weeks.

While the refresher guide is out, National Education is somewhat behind on the Instructor Refresher Guide. This means that most refresher planning will not begin until after July. Refreshers take a lot of planning, and many of the IOR's, IT's and Patrol Reps started thinking about your refresher last ski season. Normally NSP education sends the instructor guides out before the regular patroller refresher guide, but this year they are in the process of changes in both the provider side of the on-line class and the registration side for all of us patrollers. They are attempting to make it easier to register for on-line courses like the hybrid refresher, and easier to navigate the actual course. Please check with the IOR or your patrol rep for an update, and find out if you can start your on-line hybrid course.

There will be major changes in the 6th edition OEC book which is now in the process of being written, but for now we are working under the 5th edition standards and your local area protocols.

Thanks for all your hard work as an OEC Tech and all you do for the area resorts and the ski industry. Staying current as an OEC patroller is a major commitment
