## Certified Patroller Program

Here we are at the end of another great season. We were blessed with more snow than we have seen in years. Refreshers are over and this year's testing is complete. It is my hope that your season has challenged you and blessed you. Now the question "What are you going to do in the upcoming year to continue improving your skills as a Patroller?"

I, Daren Lukes, have accepted the role of Region Certified Advisor for the North Central Region. What is Certified you ask?? Certified is simply an education program sanctioned by the National Ski Patrol. It is a continuing education program for those interested in improving their skillset and then paying it forward by bringing others along on the journey.

The typical progression starts with becoming a Patroller. You navigate drinking from the firehose of the Outdoor Emergency Care book then get thrust into guiding a 6 foot toboggan down slopes steeper than you would have skied prior to beginning your journey to Patroller. After a successful test, you are congratulated and then the questions come.... "When are you going to start working on the Senior program?"

Over the next couple of years, you continue your journey, improving your skiing, refining your OEC skills, getting involved in helping your local patrol with training new Candidates, taking on leadership roles, etc. After much practice, you take the Senior program tests and Voila you are a Senior Patroller.

After you've had time to catch your breath and celebrate your success... Certified!

Certified Mission Statement;

"Certified is a national skills development and verification program that provides a readily identifiable resource of highly motivated, skilled, and knowledgeable patrollers to better serve NSP, ski area management and the outdoor recreation community."

Steps to become a Certified Patroller:

Senior Alpine Patroller with 5 years of NSP membership.

Read Chapter 12 of the Ski Patrollers Manual.

Talk to a Certified Patroller and/or your Region Certified Advisor about the program.

Download the Central Division Certified Manual and National Study Guide (beta).

Fill out application and submit to Certified Program Supervisor prior to January 1st.

Attend a Certified Qualification Clinic and demonstrate the skiing and tobogganing skills necessary to be accepted into the program.

Attend the annual Certified evaluation, passing all of the program modules within the allotted three year window.

I remember when I was first approached about starting my journey through the Certified program. It now seems like a distant memory but at the time I was overcome with fear, excitement, happiness, sadness, and any other emotion one can conceive. At the onset it seems like there is no light at the end of the tunnel and a mountain almost impossible to climb. On the contrary, if you are motivated, willing to commit, love to learn, love to meet new people and make new friends, success is within reach! Certified is simply a group of Patrollers encouraging each other to refine skills you all currently possess.

This past season their patrol was down a few in numbers but they are hoping to add more patrollers with a challenge course for a few members that were shadowing this past year.

Granite Peak Ski Area – Season began in mid-November. Early cold weather made for good snow making conditions and then February came with over 5 feet of natural snow. Current Patrol Rep, Marie Traska is in her final year of leading as the Patrol Rep. Her term will end on June 30. Chuck Jonas will then take over with Christy Parks as the Assistant PR. On March 2, eight candidates completed becoming alpine patrollers with the successful passing of their ski and toboggan evaluation. On March 10, sixteen people tried out for next year's candidate class that will begin the first Sunday of August.

Navarrino Ski area – Two years ago, weather and other factors caused a large portion of the ski hill to erode away forcing the ski hill to not open for skiing. Then, this past year due to unforeseen circumstances, Navarrino was not able to open their tubing hill. Not sure of what the future will hold for them. Some of the patrollers listed on their roster had patrolled at other hills, however, this was not possible for everyone.



Nine Mile Ski Area – This past year the season started late due to the lack of natural snow. Some of the events scheduled for early season needed to be canceled. Steve Konkel continues to be the Patrol Rep for the area.



Pine Mountain Ski Area – Over the past 2 years, Jay Van Zeeland has worked on and completed an online class by spending numerous hours narrating all chapters from the OEC 5 book. With this new class structure, students are able to listen to the lectures during their own time and then when the classes meet face to face, everyone is able to focus on the hands-on component of the training. This program is available to anyone going through OEC and could receive 4 college credits.

For the 2018-19 season, 4 candidates successfully completed their patroller training and were added to the Pine Mountain Ski Patrol. Over the winter months, 4 more students were enrolled in a new candidate class where they are doing the toboggan training on Saturdays and then meeting for the hands on OEC training on Sundays.

Standing Rocks Ski Area – With the new snow making equipment and then the large amount of new snow in February made for a great and successful year. Their cross-country ski trails with lighting and the Fat Tire Bike trails were also expanded this past year. Plans are underway to add a tubing hill and also a new warming house that will stay open 24 hours per day. Patrol Representative Carrie Butt, anticipates the need for additional patrollers to keep up with all the expansions planned for this ski area.

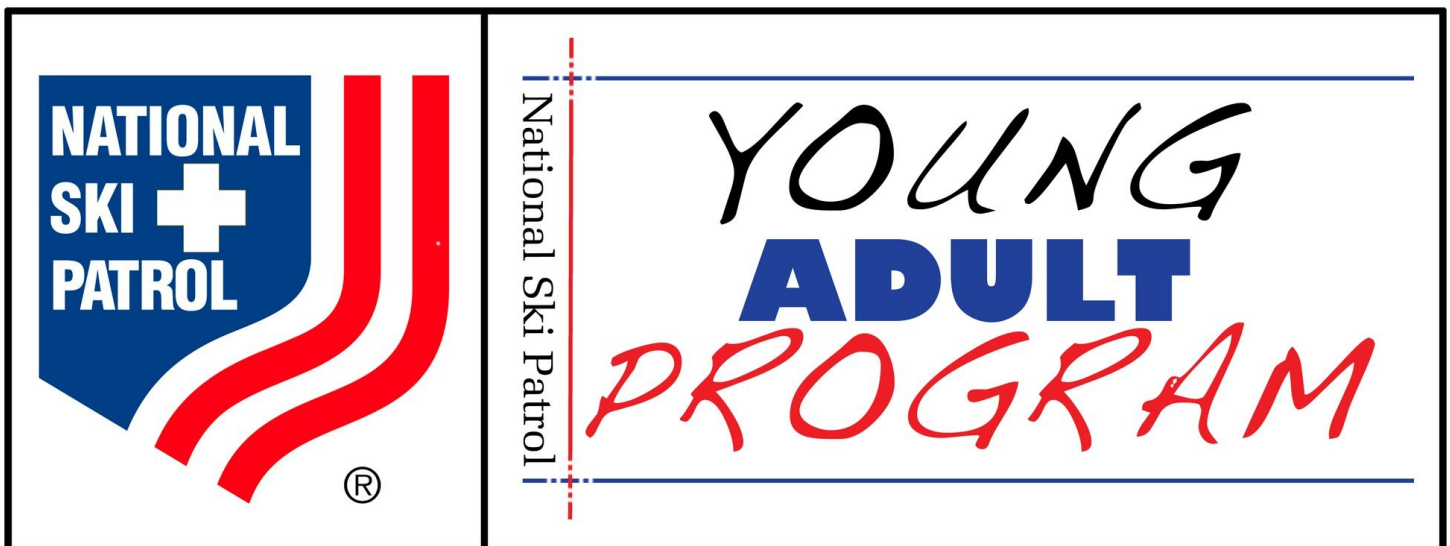

The program will allow candidates to watch the lectures, read and take quizzes on their own time and then learn hands-on skills in class sessions at your resort or training location. Offering classes during the summer time can also help you recruit youth when their workload is lighter and allows them to concentrate more on these important topics.

**Minimum Qualifications**

1. Must be registered NSP member in the section.
2. Must have been NSP Patrol Director for one year or NSP member for five years.
3. Must be familiar with the national policies as defined in the NSP Officer's Handbook and the Ski Patroller's Manual.
4. Must be familiar with Division and Section policies as applicable.

**Recommended Qualifications**

1. Served as Patrol Director one year
2. Logged at least 45 active days patrolling (Excluding refreshers, tests, etc.) with at least one third in section.
3. Experience working with management at ski area in the section.
4. Participation in Region activities (meetings testing/training, events, etc.)
5. Should be registered in the Division and senior patroller in any discipline.

**Duties and Responsibilities**

1. Serves term in accordance with Central Division by-laws NSP.
2. Supports and fosters NSP mission statement. Promotes NSP education programs within Section to

maintain integrity of NSP training and promote efficient delivery/service.

3. Cooperates with Region Director and other NSP officers in maintaining rules, regulations, and standards of the NSP.
4. Submits annual activity report to the RD and if necessary financial report to the Region Treasurer.
5. Facilitates communication to and from the Region Director, NSP Unit Rep, Ski Area Patrol Rep and NSP members and any other duties assigned by RD or Region Board of Directors.
6. Works cooperatively with Unit Reps to facilitate registration, dues payment and financial reports in a timely manner.
7. Actively participates in region func-

tions.

8. Maintains Section records as directed by the RD or Region Policy.
9. Perform as mentor and coach to prospective NSP leaders in Section.
10. Visit each unit in section annually.

**Nomination Procedure**

Any active patroller in good standing may nominate or make self-nomination. Fill out form below and send to Region Elections Coordinator. Form must be post marked by April 1, 2019.

Electorate

The electorate, having one vote each, consists of Unit Representatives as of December 31, 2017.

Elections Procedure: Region Elections Coordinator verifies and notifies all candidates. Ballots will be mailed to eligible voters by March 2019. Ballots must be returned by April 5, 2019. Results will be announced April 20, 2019.
